#### **SUMMARY**

Army Criminal Investigation Division has disseminated a Lookout with Reward on a stolen demolition shaped charge contained in its shipping crate, (Defense Identification Code M421 and Lot #: ITH85F001-004, its last known location 7 Nov 2025, Ammunition Supply Point on Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri. This charge is used in forced entry into fortified environments, which have a variety of uses for combat engineers and special operations.

#### **ANALYSIS**

INOBSCURA reporting and analysis this theft is a very grave indicator especially considering the discovery, then USACID resorted to a reward strategy, after at least 2-3 months of investigative action. This also indicates the SUBJECTS' proficiency in intelligence, targeting, access and exfiltration. This includes the absolute sinister deployment of both stolen military grade and improvised explosive devices across the operational spectrum.

A criminal investigation was initiated after an apparent inquiry could not locate the missing device. Noted is the two-month time element before CID made a public lookout for help. The theft could have occurred anywhere along the supply chain including transport and storage at Fort Leonard Wood. Insiders cannot be excluded.

The INOBSCURA motive for all report and product dissemination is the actual or potential nexus to protection of Christians, churches and other equity, especially considering the attacks of record. The whole of the terrorist, anarchist elements' operations in the United States to include the evil information operations and taunting of Hollywood and high-level elected officials' verbally inciting the targeting for attack on open media operational propaganda are terrorist activity. The shaped charge was from Department of Defense Identification Code M421 and Lot #: ITH85F001-004, its last known location was on November 7, 2025 at the Ammunition Supply Point on Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri.





## Traffic Light Protocol (TLP) Definitions

Color	When should it be used?	How may it be shared?
 <p><b>TLP:RED</b> For the eyes and ears of individual recipients only, no further disclosure.</p>	Sources may use TLP:RED when information cannot be effectively acted upon without significant risk for the privacy, reputation, or operations of the organizations involved.	Recipients may therefore not share TLP:RED information with anyone else. In the context of a meeting, for example, TLP:RED information is limited to those present at the meeting.
 <p><b>TLP:AMBER</b> Limited disclosure, recipients can only spread this on a need-to-know basis within their organization and its clients. Note that <b>TLP:AMBER+STRICT</b> restricts sharing to the organization only.</p>	Sources may use TLP:AMBER when information requires support to be effectively acted upon, yet carries risk to privacy, reputation, or operations if shared outside of the organizations involved.	Recipients may share TLP:AMBER information with members of their own organization and its clients, but only on a need-to-know basis to protect their organization and its clients and prevent further harm. Note: if the source wants to restrict sharing to the organization only, they must specify TLP:AMBER+STRICT.
