Situation: Tanzania bans political rallies ahead of youth-led protests

Summary: Tanzania's interior minister, Patrobas Katambi, said on Friday the government was banning all political rallies, less than two weeks before youth-led protests planned for July 7. Katambi told lawmakers in parliament that the ban was because of security threats and did not say how long it would last. The protesters plan to gather on the July 7 public holiday to call for democratic reforms and justice for people killed in election violence last year.

Situation: North Korea: Kim Jong Un oversees ballistic missile tests

Summary: North Korean leader Kim Jong Un oversaw tests of "special mission" warhead for a tactical ballistic missile, state media KCNA reported on Friday, as Pyongyang pushes for an "offensive posture" along its border with South Korea. While supervising the tests of "major weapons" Kim said North Korea's self-defense policy includes an objective to strengthen "the deadly and destructive offensive posture to make no enemy dare to confront," according to KCNA. The tests were conducted on the anniversary of the outbreak of the 1950-53 Korean War.

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Summary: A complaint alleging kidnapping, wrongful confinement, assault and extortion inside a sports club in Guwahati has been filed with the city police, with the complainant claiming he was held captive for nearly four hours by a group of 25 to 30 people. The complainant, Noman Dewan, a resident of Fancy Bazar and an active Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) worker, alleged that the incident took place at Break Point Sports Club near Nehru Stadium on B. Barooah College Road on June 21. In his complaint, Dewan alleged that he was unlawfully confined inside the club premises and subjected to physical and mental assault.

Situation: Russian attacks kill 4, injure 38 across Ukraine over past day, Romania scrambles helicopter amid attack near border

Summary: Russian attacks across Ukraine killed at least four people and injured at least 38 others over the past day, regional authorities reported on June 26, while a Russian drone attack on southern Odesa Oblast caused Romania to issue an air alert during the night. The Romanian Defense Ministry said on June 26 that Russia's new wave of drone attacks on southern Ukraine, near the river border with Romania, forced the NATO member to scramble a helicopter at around 4 a.m. local time to monitor aerial targets.

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Summary: Sweden has violated several provisions of the European Social Charter by refusing to provide necessary health care to migrants of Roma origin, the Council of Europe said on Friday, also criticizing the difference in treatment applied to them compared to other undocumented people, AFP reports. In 2023, Amnesty International and Médecins du Monde - International filed a complaint showing that, in 129 cases, Roma were either denied necessary health care or were billed the full cost of care, which discouraged them from seeking it.

Summary: The Kremlin said Friday it was aware of, but had not yet seen, a viral video featuring a Russian man identifying himself as a Ukraine war veteran who threatened to stage an armed uprising unless President Vladimir Putin met with him to discuss the alleged abuse of soldiers by military commanders. In the video, which has garnered millions of views on social media, a man in military uniform identifying himself as Alexander Lunin asked for an audience with Putin to “tell the whole truth” about the mistreatment of Russian troops. In a second Instagram video published Thursday, Lunin reiterated his demands to be received by the president.

During a hearing before the House Appropriations Subcommittee on Homeland Security, the official defended the construction of physical barriers and technological reinforcement in the border area. Mullin stated that there are currently nine cartels operating in the region and that, according to him, there is not "a single centimeter" of the northern Mexican border that is not under the control of a criminal organization.

Summary: One of Myanmar's largest private banks has acknowledged a cyberattack on its digital infrastructure, though it maintains that its core financial networks remain secure after an international extortion group claimed a massive data breach. The hacking group, calling itself LAPSUS\$, claimed on June 23 to have stolen more than 120 gigabytes of data from AYA Bank. The group threatened to publish the compromised information on the dark web by July 8 unless a ransom is paid.

Push Security discovered what they dub as the "Poisoned Tenant" campaign after multiple employees received invitations to join an OpenAI organization named "Push Security Inc." While the invite was legitimate, coming directly from OpenAI, the ChatGPT tenant had been created by an attacker using Gmail addresses rather than by the company.

Per Binding Operational Directive (BOD) 26-04, the remediation is deemed urgent and must be addressed by Sunday, June 28.

Summary: The FBI and CISA are warning that a phishing campaign targeting Signal users tied to Russian intelligence services has evolved to steal Signal Backup Recovery Keys, allowing attackers to access victims' historical messages. The updated public service announcement is an update to a March 2026 advisory that warned the threat actors were targeting users of commercial messaging applications, particularly Signal, through phishing campaigns designed to hijack accounts rather than break end-to-end encryption. "RIS cyber threat actors continue to masquerade as automated CMA support accounts in updated phishing messages but have evolved their tactics to attempt to elicit victims' Backup Recovery Keys," warns an FBI PSA published today.

Summary: Torrential rain battered Taiwan for a second day Friday and caused widespread flooding nationwide that led to at least two deaths as rising waters stranded residents and prompted emergency rescues. As of noon Friday, 487 floods had been recorded across Taiwan since early Thursday morning, with the most in Kaohsiung (104), followed by Pingtung County (95), Taipei (82), and Tainan (79), while 74 areas remained under water,

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according to the Ministry of Economic Affairs (MOEA). Premier Cho Jung-tai (卓榮泰) on Friday morning directed the MOEA to aid local governments with pumping machines to clear inundated areas, the ministry said in a news release.

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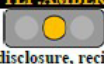
