IN OBSCURA ANALYSIS

The following Fairfax County Fire and Rescue Service media release requests public help in identifying subjects who are suspected of arson. The location is assigned to the global rescue team operated by the department, Virginia Task Force One, currently in the news for as they have a team deployed to the major earthquake in Venezuela. A large shed on the compound was destroyed and a million dollars in estimated damage. The impact on mission is not stated.

The imagery included are of subjects who gained unauthorized entry into the training compound used the Urban Search and Rescue Division. The area of the facility is industrial zoned and mixed rural located along the county's southern border on the Occoquan River with Prince William County. The images released depict five (cited six in media reporting) subjects attired in dark clothing with one wearing a backpack. It is unknown how they gained entry, which is presumed forced entry.

That entry was by a team of six, and in reviewing news media images of the fire scene, In Obscura suspects this is a Direct Action Cell, considering the amount of fire and damage. This further lends itself to pre-operational surveillance and planning for the right time

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element to attack in a remote industrial location, virtually unoccupied after hours, late on Saturday afternoon.

LORTON, Va. (7News) — A fire that started at a [Virginia Task Force 1](#) training facility in Lorton over the weekend is believed to have caused more than \$1 million in damage, with crews now searching for those responsible, according to [Fairfax County](#) Fire and Rescue officials.

Security video obtained by Fire and Rescue officials showed six people trespassing around the time of a fire engulfing a storage shed that held training equipment used by the Urban Search and Rescue team at around 5 p.m. on Saturday.

At the facility in the days after crews extinguished the fire, you could see the charred remnants of the building and all of the items inside.

Inside the shed was a semi-tractor-trailer and other transportation equipment, a spokesperson for the Task Force said.

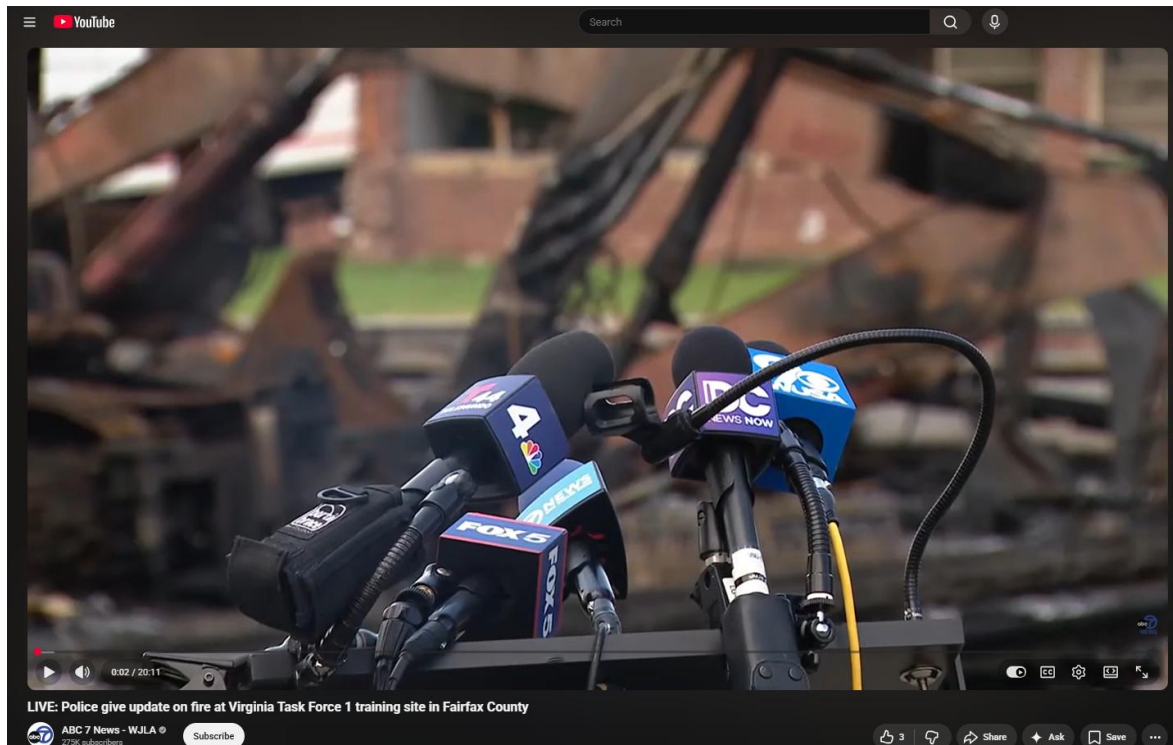

The Fairfax County Fire and Rescue Department and the Fairfax County Police Department are asking for the public's help identifying individuals captured on surveillance video in connection with a fire at the Fairfax County Fire and Rescue Department's Urban Search and Rescue (USAR) training facility in Lorton.

On Saturday, June 27, 2026, at approximately 5:20 p.m., the Fairfax County Fire and Rescue Department responded to reports of a large column of black smoke coming from the USAR training facility located in the 9900 block of Furnace Road. Crews arrived to find a large storage facility with commercial equipment fully engulfed in flames. There were no civilian or firefighter injuries.

Fire investigators are continuing to investigate the cause of the fire. In addition to the FCFRD investigation, the Fairfax County Police Department is conducting a criminal investigation.

The facility supports training for the Fairfax County USAR allowing them to remain trained and ready to respond to disasters throughout the world. The team is currently deployed to assist with recovery following the devastating Venezuela earthquake.

Surveillance video from the facility shows several individuals at the location around the time of the fire. Anyone who recognizes the individuals or who has information about the incident is asked to submit a tip through Crime Solvers by phone – **1-866-411-TIPS (866-411-8477)**, and by web – [Click HERE](#).

You can remain anonymous. Anonymous tipsters are eligible for a cash reward of up to \$5,000. Download the 'P3 Tips' App "Fairfax Co Crime Solvers." Please leave contact information if you wish for a fire investigator to follow up with you.

Traffic Light Protocol (TLP) Definitions

Color	When should it be used?	How may it be shared?
 TLP:RED For the eyes and ears of individual recipients only, no further disclosure.	Sources may use TLP:RED when information cannot be effectively acted upon without significant risk for the privacy, reputation, or operations of the organizations involved.	Recipients may therefore not share TLP:RED information with anyone else. In the context of a meeting, for example, TLP:RED information is limited to those present at the meeting.
 TLP:AMBER Limited disclosure, recipients can only spread this on a need-to-know basis within their organization and its clients. Note that TLP:AMBER+STRICT restricts sharing to the organization only.	Sources may use TLP:AMBER when information requires support to be effectively acted upon, yet carries risk to privacy, reputation, or operations if shared outside of the organizations involved.	Recipients may share TLP:AMBER information with members of their own organization and its clients, but only on a need-to-know basis to protect their organization and its clients and prevent further harm. Note: if the source wants to restrict sharing to the organization only, they must specify TLP:AMBER+STRICT.
 TLP:GREEN Limited disclosure, recipients can spread this within their community.	Sources may use TLP:GREEN when information is useful to increase awareness within their wider community.	Recipients may share TLP:GREEN information with peers and partner organizations within their community, but not via publicly accessible channels. TLP:GREEN information may not be shared outside of the community. Note: when “community” is not defined, assume the cybersecurity/defense community.
 TLP: CLEAR Recipients can spread this to the world, there is no limit on disclosure.	Sources may use TLP:CLEAR when information carries minimal or no foreseeable risk of misuse, in accordance with applicable rules and procedures for public release.	Subject to standard copyright rules, TLP:CLEAR information may be shared without restriction.
