(TLP-C) ANALYSIS PROPOSED BILL PROTECTING CHURCHES DURING PROTESTS

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IN OBSCURA ANALYSIS

A prayerfully welcome federally enforced deterrent in the face of elevating violence against Christians from the Red Green Alliance in the United States. This has all been multilayered cellular terror attack operations focused on several targets, with one, American churches, related facilities, Clergy and Christians. This bill only restricts proxemics of protected activity under the First Amendment beyond a 100 foot distance.

The In Obscura position is that churches are private property, what I term the inner perimeter. This might mean in large church properties these “protests” can take place on church private property but outside the 100 foot minimum requirement, still a threat box. The “protests” at a minimum occurring at the Cities Church in St. Paul MN and the Mission Church In Carlsbad, CA are among several others where the inner perimeter was breached in terror (fear) operations and the church interior was attacked.

Mission Church tolerated three different iterations of these attacks, while protests continued on church property outside. This bill seems to also aid in the protection of the growing number of Christian Revivals and open air, mass gathering activities such as mass baptisms, church outside recreational activities as a few examples.

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It is highly recommended that churches have in place standing Memorandums of Understanding (MOU) with law enforcement which permits the police/sheriff unfettered access to that private property for proactive patrols and checks, while also critically enforcing trespassing law. This MOU will empower security officers and or clergy to have people removed and legally banned from the property for cause. If they return, criminal charges are filed.

Not much different from a shopping mall as an example. With this, signage is required to ensure public notice, such as “no trespassing, soliciting loitering.” The congregation should be openly briefed and even the website explain openly why these initiatives have been taken to ensure that those who come to worship or seek help can do so in a safe environment, void of fear^{i ii}.

Reps. Brad Knott, R-N.C., and Tom Suozzi, D-N.Y., are introducing a bill to make it a crime to knowingly disrupt or impede people from attending a religious service.

That includes demonstrations taking place within 100 feet "from any pedestrian or vehicular entryway of any house of worship, during the period beginning 1 hour before the start of and ending 1 hour after the conclusion of a scheduled religious service," according to legislative text obtained by Fox News Digital. A violation of those guidelines would carry a \$2,500 civil fine on the first offense, a \$5,000 penalty on the second offense, and \$10,000 for a third.

The bill does carve out limitations, however, such as demonstrations that are taking place with a federal, state, or local government-issued permit. The text's language also specifically classifies disruptions based on things like volume, duration, and impact, rather than the content of speech — meaning the First Amendment is still protected.

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TRAFFIC LIGHT PROTOCOL REQUIREMENTS FOR DISSEMINATION

Traffic Light Protocol (TLP) Definitions

Color	When should it be used?	How may it be shared?
 TLP:RED For the eyes and ears of individual recipients only, no further disclosure.	Sources may use TLP:RED when information cannot be effectively acted upon without significant risk for the privacy, reputation, or operations of the organizations involved.	Recipients may therefore not share TLP:RED information with anyone else. In the context of a meeting, for example, TLP:RED information is limited to those present at the meeting.
 TLP:AMBER Limited disclosure, recipients can only spread this on a need-to-know basis within their organization and its clients. Note that TLP:AMBER+STRICT restricts sharing to the organization only.	Sources may use TLP:AMBER when information requires support to be effectively acted upon, yet carries risk to privacy, reputation, or operations if shared outside of the organizations involved.	Recipients may share TLP:AMBER information with members of their own organization and its clients, but only on a need-to-know basis to protect their organization and its clients and prevent further harm. Note: if the source wants to restrict sharing to the organization only, they must specify TLP:AMBER+STRICT.
 TLP:GREEN Limited disclosure, recipients can spread this within their community.	Sources may use TLP:GREEN when information is useful to increase awareness within their wider community.	Recipients may share TLP:GREEN information with peers and partner organizations within their community, but not via publicly accessible channels. TLP:GREEN information may not be shared outside of the community. Note: when “community” is not defined, assume the cybersecurity/defense community.
 TLP: CLEAR Recipients can spread this to the world, there is no limit on disclosure.	Sources may use TLP:CLEAR when information carries minimal or no foreseeable risk of misuse, in accordance with applicable rules and procedures for public release.	Subject to standard copyright rules, TLP:CLEAR information may be shared without restriction.

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
